### When do I need to say something? Maybe

you've asked yourself this question as a parent. You see your child struggling, from attempting to tie their shoes homework to deciding on what college to attend, and wonder if you should say something. Or maybe you've wondered that when you see your friend or sibling continually hurt because of their own choices. Or maybe you've been frustrated by someone else's words that don't hurt you directly but hurt others around you. Either way, I imagine you've asked yourself that question, "When should I say something?"

And I've struggled with that question many times over the past several months. Especially since we as a church have adopted a new conflict resolution guideline policy. If you haven't heard about that policy, I encourage you to check out our website and read more about it. The first part of that policy really focuses on our personal responsibility to conflict resolution. We call it the 'self-reflection and prayer' portion of the policy. This is where we pray and reflect on our part in the conflict. And, personally, I don't mind this part of the policy. Where I struggle, though, is when do I need to go to number 2, the 'one on one conversation'? When does a situation come to the point that I need to say something? When do I need to make my voice heard and express my opinion and pain? And I honestly struggle with that. I ask myself, 'do I truly need to be heard or am I just wanted to attack that person?' I also ask, 'is my pain that severe that I need to make sure the other person knows it, or should I just let it go?' So, when do I need to say something?

And, honestly, I haven't come up with a clear answer. I know it's not healthy to just pretend everything is okay when it's not. I know that if I go home and complain to my wife about what

happened, that isn't good either. And it's even worse when I continue to complain to her because that person continues to do the thing that bothers me even though I haven't told them it bothers me (which of course we'd never do!). And I don't want us to be a church that just ignores issues and doesn't say things because we don't want to offend anyone. But there are times we need to just let things go, too.

And so, where's the line? I don't know. It's really an individual question that we need to ask on a per case basis. But, again, I know I've appreciated being informed of times I offended others. I know I don't want to continue to offend them, and I probably will if they don't tell me. And I know others feel the same. And so, sometimes, it's the most loving thing we can do to say something.

And so, I encourage you, if you've been wanting to say something, especially if it's lingered for weeks or months, please do. In a loving, gracious and kind way, please follow the guidelines that have been outlined by the church and help us to grow as a church body. I pray that through our efforts we will grow into a deeper and more meaningful relationship with one another, and through that, closer to Jesus.
