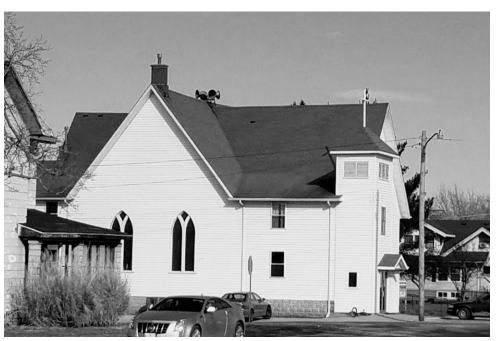

### What did the beaver say to the

tree? It's been nice gnawing (knowing) you! Just this past week, someone was showing me pictures of beavers that he and others have trapped. In looking at these images, it's safe to say that I won't be trying to keep a beaver for a pet! They're large and somewhat mangy animals. Anyway, it got me thinking about how we view beavers. And the phrase that came to mind was 'busy little beaver', which got me thinking about where we get that phrase. Though I don't know for certain, I assume it has something to do with their tenacious gnawing habits. Did you know beavers gnaw for good reason? Apparently, beaver's teeth constantly grow. And their continuous gnawing wears down their teeth to a manageable level. If they didn't gnaw, their teeth would grow so large that they'd have trouble eating. So, beavers are busy for good reason.

But what about us? I know all of us are busy with schedules full of meeting and events and family functions. Most ofour busyness isn't bad, but often in our busyness things come into conflict. We have to choose between two important things in our life. Adding kids and their schedules only amplifies the struggle. But what do we end up choosing when we have that conflict? What often gets pushed to the side?

I know for me, when I was working 6 days a week delivering mail, I had a difficult time some Sundays getting motivated to go to church. Just to be honestly, it felt like Sundays were my only day to sleep in and rest a little and going to church wasn't always an easy decision. But I also knew that if I missed Sunday

services, I missed out on community and opportunities to grow and be encouraged. The verses in Hebrews 10.24-25 really made sense to me, "And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near." (ESV) We truly need to be together, especially when it comes to building one another up and caring for each other. I understand all of the busyness and the scheduling stuff and I know it's hard – and I certainly don't expect everyone to be at everything the church does – but the more we're together, the more we can share our lives, the more we build our community and our souls.

If you haven't been to our Sunday services for a while, starting March 12th, we'll be doing a unique Easter series called 'AHA', which is a 40 day journey helping us lift each other up well. See you there!
